- Globally acclaimed transparent auction of 5G license (3.5GHz) spectrum band (2021)
- Achievement of 40.88% Broadband penetration as at December 2021
- Successfully launched a new Nigerian National Broadband Plan (2020 - 2025) with a target of 90% penetration by 2025
- Currently implementing a National Digital Economy Policy and Strategy (2020 -2030) plan to accelerate the development of a digital economy in Nigeria.
- Implementation of a National Policy for Indigenous Content Promotion and Adoption in the Nigerian Telecommunications Sector
- Successfully established Computer Security Incidence Response Team (CSIRT)<sup>7</sup>
